PLEASE DON'T

PARKING AND DROP OFF

We offer free on-site parking for all guests of Chesters Stables. Please don't park anywhere other than the allocated spaces. For disabled access and drop off, please drive into the main courtyard. **Please refrain from parking in our main courtyard**. Once you've unloaded your luggage, please park in one of our three car park areas: A, B or C. You can access Car Park C by exiting the stable block and re-entering using the separate driveway and following the signs. Please refrain from parking on the road.

DOGS

We offer four dog-friendly Stable Suites to accommodate four-legged members of the family. Please keep dogs on a lead when exploring our grounds and always clean up after them using the bin provided. For safety purposes, we also ask that you do not leave your dog alone in your Stable Suite at any time.

Guests are asked to adhere to the guidelines listed in the terms and conditions regarding dogs on furniture as failure to comply will result in excess cleaning charges.

SMOKING

We operate a strict no smoking policy in Chesters Stables. Smoking is only permitted in designated outdoor smoking areas, which have been clearly marked for your convenience.

IN YOUR STABLE SUITE

WIFI

Complimentary WiFi is available in all rooms and public areas throughout Chesters Stables. The password for our WiFi is '**walwickhall**'. Please be aware due to the nature of the building and its rural location and your network coverage you may experience issues with reception. We would recommend where possible to use WiFi calling on your phone. Please also note that whilst we have the fastest possible WiFi in this area, that speeds may be reduced at peak times.

SECURITY

Each Stable Suite has been fitted with a safe. This is located in a bedroom wardrobe. Please follow the instructions provided. If you forget your code or are unsure how to use your safe please contact Reception.

DOCTORS

In the event of an emergency please dial 111 and seek advice from the operator.

VET

Our nearest vet is Orchard House Veterinary Centre based in Hexham. You can contact them on 01434 607 677.

FIRE

In the event of a fire, please leave your Stable Suite and ensure all windows and doors are closed to contain the fire. Each Stable Suite is fitted with a fire blanket and a multi fuel extinguisher. These are both located in the kitchen. Please note, penalties for mis-use of the fire equipment will apply.

REFUSE COLLECTION

There are three bins in your Stable Suite. One is for general waste, one is for mixed recycling waste, and one is for mixed glass bottles. If your bins are full, please empty them into the larger bins located at the rear of the stable block in Car Park C. We ask guests to empty bins into the larger bins at the end of their stay as outlined in the terms and conditions. Failure to comply will result in an additional charge.

Slightly further afield sit the Northumberland coast, the Scottish borders, the North-East's vibrant capital Newcastle upon Tyne and, just past our estate, you can find Kielder, the UK's largest natural reservoir. However you choose to spend your time with us is entirely up to you. But one thing is for certain - you won't be short of things to see.







CHESTERS STABLES

Chesters Stables offers eight luxury Stable Suites, each benefiting from a private terrace area, planted with English garden classics. From generous mezzanine floors with large glass frontages to original stable detailing dividing the living space, each Stable Suite is unique in design and individual in taste. While elements of the Stable Suites are unconventional, inside everything you'd expect from a luxury bolt-hole come as standard; kingsized bedrooms all with en-suite baths, living areas with toe-warming open fireplaces and wood-burning stoves, a country-style kitchen with dining areas where guests can rustle up leisurely breakfasts or intimate candlelit meals. Add to this list washing machines, tumble dryers, dishwashers and you'll start to see we've thought of everything you'll need to feel like you're at home, albeit a very well designed one.

Contemporary in design, the Stable Suites boast sumptuous sofas, warm tones, deep-pile carpets and generous use of marble, which are all designed to create a homely ambience and leave you wanting to stay for longer.



BRINGING CHESTERS BACK TO LIFE

These fully renovated Stable Suites started life in 1891 as part of the Chesters Estate. Reborn in 2018, these 1, 2, 3 and 4 bedroomed Stable Suites now rest amongst grassed and wooded grounds owned by the Walwick Estate Group, who also own Matfen Hall.

200 YEARS IN THE MAKING

Chesters Stables were originally built as an extension of Chesters House, an 18th century country mansion. Chesters House was built for John Errington of Walwick Grange in about 1771, and was eventually inherited by John Clayton in 1822. Clayton was the town clerk for Newcastle upon Tyne and a keen antiquarian. He went on to excavate the ruins of Chesters Roman Fort and then, in 1855, buy more than 20 miles of land along the west Hadrian's Wall to protect it for the first time. Up until then the locals had been removing stones from the wall for their own building projects. Clayton went on to rebuild large sections of the wall to the standard we see today. Architect Norman Shaw extended Chesters House in 1891, building five two-storeyed three-bay wings and a stable block, now known as Chesters Stables. The stables were originally designed as stabling with groom's accommodation around a courtyard. Many of its original equestrian features have been preserved to this day to keep the essential character of the building.

HADRIAN'S WALL

84 miles long, nearly 2000 years old, a UNESCO World Heritage Site - and right on our doorstep. Hadrian's Wall gives a fascinating insight into our Roman heritage. Set in the stunning local landscape of rolling hills and wide skies it really is an inspiring sight to behold. Whatever your reason for visiting Hadrian's Wall, be it to discover its history, admire the unique landscape, take on the challenge of walking-the-wall, or just the chance to 'see it up close and personal', we have hand-picked experienced guides ready to assist. For around three centuries, Hadrian's Wall was a vibrant, multi-cultured frontier sprawling almost 90 miles coast-to-coast. Built by a force of 15,000 men in under six years, it's as astounding today for its sheer vision as it is for its engineering. Milecastles, barracks, ramparts and forts punctuate a diverse landscape that provides a dramatic backdrop. However you discover it, Hadrian's Wall is a unique, must-see monument and a remarkable place to experience.

CHESTERS ROMAN FORT

See what life was like at one of the Roman Empire's most northern outposts. Built just after Hadrian's Wall was completed in AD 123, Chesters Roman Fort is the most complete Roman cavalry fort in Britain and is located just a short walk down the road from Chesters Stables. Wander around the unusually well-preserved baths, steam room and officers' quarters. before discovering an amazing collection of Roman objects and inscriptions in the museum that were found at the fort and along Hadrian's Wall.

NORTHUMBERLAND NATIONAL PARK

Voted National Park of the Year 2018, Northumberland is the least populated of all the National Parks and home to England's cleanest rivers, clearest air and darkest skies. Northumberland boasts an abundance of beautiful landscapes, activities and wildlife to explore, ensuring you'll never be short of something to do. Immerse yourself in history at Hadrian's Wall, enjoy some retail therapy in the local market towns and villages, or simply relax and get back to nature with a walk through one of the many peaceful woodlands.

HEXHAM

Hexham is a vibrant market town, often considered the jewel in Northumberland's crown. Hexham has an abundance of historical and cultural attractions for visitors to enjoy, including Hexham Abbey, which has been a place of Christian worship since AD674. Stroll down to the bustling market place or visit Hexham's large selection of art galleries that showcase the town's thriving artistic community. If the weather permits, take time to enjoy a gentle walk in the picturesque Tyne Green Country Park or along the beautiful banks of the river.

Distance from Chesters Stables: approx 5 miles

HEXHAM OLD GAOL

The Hexham Old Gaol is the earliest documented purpose-built prison in England. Positioned in the centre of town, Hexham Old Gaol was built between 1330 and 1333 and was used as a prison for almost 500 years. Today it houses a museum where you'll find interactive displays on archaeology, costumes, armour and textiles, as well as a range of familyfriendly activities to enjoy.

Distance from Chesters Stables: approx 6 miles

HEXHAM ABBEY

Hexham Abbey has been a place of Christian worship since AD674 and today presents 1,300 years of its history as a priory and parish church in the very centre of the thriving market town of Hexham. With many fascinating exhibits and hands-on experiences to enjoy, Hexham Abbey is ideal for all ages.

Distance from Chesters Stables: approx 7 miles

AYDON CASTLE

Just a stone's throw away from Hadrian's Wall lies Aydon Castle, one of the finest and most unaltered examples of a 13th century English manor house. Set in beautiful and secluded Northumberland woodland, Aydon Castle is over 900 years old and boasts a fascinating history for visitors to discover.

Distance from Chesters Stables: approx 8 miles

CORBRIDGE

Filled with history and charm, Corbridge is one of the prettiest places to visit in the county. Wander along the quaint streets as you explore the village's artisan bookshops, art galleries, family-run bakeries and boutiques that boast beautifully decorated fronts.

Distance from Chesters Stables: approx 9 miles

THE SILL

The Sill is a National Landscape Discovery Centre in Northumberland National Park, built to excite and inspire people of all ages to explore the landscape, history, culture and heritage of Northumberland. The Sill features exhibitions, learning and event spaces, a local food café, a world-class Youth Hostel and a shop specialising in local crafts and produce.

Distance from Chesters Stables: approx 10 miles

VINDOLANDA

With unique exhibits and live archaeology to watch, an unforgettable day out awaits at Vindolanda. Formerly a key military post on the northern frontier of Britain, Vindolanda is the home of Britain's 'Top Treasure' - the Vindolanda Writing Tablets - and is one of Europe's most important Roman archaeological sites, with live excavations taking place every year. The recently-refurbished on-site museum provides a breathtaking exploration of the Trust's ongoing discoveries and accounts of Roman life.

Distance from Chesters Stables: approx 11 miles

HARESHAW LINN WATERFALL

Take a magical walk to Hareshaw Linn, where you'll cross no less than six bridges to reach the beautiful nine-metre high waterfall. The waterfall is set in fantastic ancient woodland, where you'll also find plenty of rare plant life and wildlife such as red squirrels, great spotted woodpeckers, wood warblers, badgers and Daubenton's bats.

Distance from Chesters Stables: approx 12 miles

BELSAY HALL, CASTLE & GARDENS

With so much to see and do, a trip to Belsay is one of the best value family days out in the North East of England. Admire the beauty of the Grand Grecian Hall, inspired by a honeymoon trip to Athens, before losing yourselves in Belsay's twenty acres of stunning gardens. The castle's vast Northumberland surroundings can also be enjoyed from the top of the 14th-century tower, also known as 'Pele tower'. Beautiful gardens, impressive architecture and stunning views all in one place makes the castle a must-see on any visit to Northumberland.

WALLINGTON HALL

Wallington is a Grade I listed building located near the village of Cambo. It has been owned by the National Trust since 1942, after it was donated complete with the estate and farms by Sir Charles Philips Trevelyan, the first donation of its kind. A family home for over 300 years, the house is full of beautiful furniture, family paintings, treasured collections and quirky curiosities to see. And, with over 13,000 acres to explore, there's plenty of walking or cycling to enjoy on the Wallington estate too; it even has a new 'Dragon' cycle trail, designed with families in mind.

Distance from Chesters Stables: approx 15 miles

WHEELBIRKS ICE CREAM PARLOUR

Wheelbirks is a firm favourite with locals. Their award-winning ice cream is made on the farm and offers an abundance of experimental and creative flavours, which have ranged from coffee and croissant to garlic and balsamic vinegar! The farm is also open to the public so you can meet the cows that make Wheelbirks' ice cream so special.

Distance from Chesters Stables: approx 16 miles

PRUDHOE CASTLE

Prudhoe Castle was built in the late 11th century to restrict Scottish expansionism. It withstood two sieges led by William the Lion and later resisted further attacks during the Wars of Independence, ultimately becoming the only castle in Northumberland never to be taken by force by a Scottish army. It stands in a picturesque location on a wooded hillside overlooking the River Tyne.

Kielder Water and Forest Park is situated just short drive from Chesters Stables - simply ask at Reception for directions and our team will be happy to help.

KIELDER OBSERVATORY

At an impressive 572 square miles, Northumberland International Dark Sky Park is Europe's largest area of protected night sky and officially England's best spot to enjoy star gazing, having been awarded Gold Tier designation by the International Dark Sky Association. Located in the heart of Northumberland International Dark Sky Park is Kielder Observatory, where you can explore the night sky using their incredible telescope. With an exciting programme of astronomical events throughout the year, there's something for all ages to enjoy.

Distance from Chesters Stables: approx 28 miles

NEWCASTLE UPON TYNE

Newcastle upon Tyne is one of England's friendliest cities and offers visitors a host of cultural experiences to enjoy, including museums, art galleries, theatres and sporting arenas. Admire Grey's Monument, stroll over the Tyne Bridge, let your imagination run wild at Centre for Life or venture out a bit further and spend a day at Gateshead's Metrocentre, Europe's largest shopping and leisure centre. Don't forget to look out for the iconic Angel of the North, the pride of the North East for more than 2,000 years.

BOLAM LAKE

Situated in the heart of the countryside, Bolam Lake is surrounded by historic landscapes and dramatic views. It has lakeside, woodland and open grassed areas for all to enjoy with an attractive lakeside walk accessible for wheelchairs and pushchairs. A very popular spot for walkers, cyclists and horse riders.

DURHAM

The beautiful city of Durham is a historical treasure trove, with castles nestle in riversides, parks thriving with deer, and museums radiating with industrial heritage. Bring your map to visit Durham County and the North Pennines where there are miles of heather-carpeted dales to explore, or visit the city's world-famous Durham Cathedral, which together with the adjacent Castle forms a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Sports fans won't short of things to do in Durham either – the city is 'cricket mad', especially when The Ashes come to town!

THE ALNWICK GARDEN & CASTLE

The Alnwick Garden is one of the world's most extraordinary contemporary gardens. The Duchess of Northumberland's vision for a forgotten plot is now a truly 21st century experience full of imagination, inspiration and fun. With a collection of over 4,000 plant varieties to discover, thousands of seasonal blooms, spell-binding water sculptures and one of the world's largest tree houses - there is plenty to surprise and delight. While you're there, why not pay a visit to the famous Alnwick Castle too, one of the largest inhabited castles in England. Built as a medieval fortress, and owned by the Percy family for over 700 years, today it is known as home to the Duke and Duchess of Northumberland as well as a filming location for Harry Potter and Downton Abbey.

Located in the heart of Northumberland International Dark Sky Park is Kielder Observatory, where you can explore the night sky using their incredible telescope. With an exciting programme of astronomical events throughout the year, there's something for all ages to enjoy.

BIRD WATCHING

Northumberland offers some of the best birdwatching spots in the country. Northumberland National Park and the North Pennines are a great place to see black grouse, golden plover and other moorland specialities, like the curlew with its evocative haunting call, and you'll find crossbills and secretive goshawks in woodlands like Kielder Water & Forest Park. A pair of ospreys has also hatched chicks in the Park for the last two years running – a record first time this has even been recorded in Northumberland. The county's rivers are home to dipper, goosander, common sandpiper and grey wagtail.

Further afield, the Farne Islands are home to terns, puffins, razorbills, kittiwakes, shags and guillemots and from close-by Coquet Island you can catch a glimpse of Britain's rarest breeding seabird, the Roseate Tern. Spring and autumn denote the migration periods and throughout winter, Holy Island and Lindisfarne NNR host the Svalbardbreeding population of Pale-bellied Brent Geese.

CYCLING

The wondrous nature, quiet roads and dramatic scenery of Northumberland makes it perfect for both road cycling and family day rides. Mountain bikers can also enjoy the Park's purpose-built trails or bridleways. Or why not explore Hadrian's Wall on two wheels? With its dramatic scenery, quiet trails and unique historic sites, there's no better route.

CHESTERS STABLES TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- A booking deposit of 25% is required to secure your Chesters Stable if made more than 6 weeks in advance. Full payment is required if booking within 6 weeks of arrival.
- Reservations and Payment of Rentals: Telephone reservations MUST be confirmed by payment of deposit, or final balance immediately. At present we can accept payment via bank transfer or credit card. Reservations are considered confirmed only upon receipt of the reservation deposit and subject to the acceptance of the reservation.
- The balance of your accommodation must be paid at least 6 weeks before your arrival date and we will contact you to remind you. Failure to pay the final deposit will result in the loss of your reservation and no refund will be made.
- 4. **Cancellations:** You have 48 hours after payment of deposit to cancel your booking, after which time any booking that is cancelled the full rental, or deposit is NOT refundable. All cancellations must be confirmed in writing and received before the due date.
- 5. Cancellation and Curtailment Insurance: It is strongly recommended that insurance be taken out for all bookings. Having to cancel your holiday for whatever reason is hard enough but the loss of deposit or total rental can come as an additional setback. To minimise this unfortunate occurrence, you should take out Holiday Insurance. When you reserve your holiday property you are entering into a legally binding contract. If you are unable to take your holiday property, then you will be liable to pay a Cancellation Charge and this could amount to the total cost of your holiday.
- 6. **Period of Let:** Rentals begin at 3.00pm on the day of arrival and end at 10.00am on the day of departure. Any delayed departure may incur additional charges at our reasonable discretion.
- 7. **Keys:** You will be sent your security code for the door lock 24 hours prior to arrival. Any lost keys or unreturned keys will result in a £100.00 fine.
- 8. **Cleaning:** The Stable will be cleaned before your arrival and it is expected that the private ownership of the Stable will be respected and that it will be left in a clean and tidy manner. If additional cleaning is required then charges may be incurred to cover additional costs.
- 9. **Damages:** If there are any "accidents" or breakages during the stay please make a note and leave in the suite for the housekeepers. You will be required to pay for replacements.
- 10. **Previous Damages:** If for whatever reason there has been damage caused in the Stable by previous guests and there are items/facilities missing, we will always do our utmost to have these resolved before

your arrival. If they cannot be repaired/replaced by the time of your arrival then we cannot be held responsible for this. If in the rare occasion that this happens we will contact you as soon as possible to make you aware

- 11. Restrictions on Rental: The owners reserve the right to refuse rentals or terminate a rental for improper use or unacceptable behaviour. Rentals will not be accepted in respect of any guest under 21 years old. It is also as condition of booking that no Stable can be sub-let to a Third Party by the Principal Guest. If this is found to be the case, the Third Party will have no legal right of occupancy and will be required to vacate the suite. Guests right to occupy the property may be forfeited without compensation if; 1. Any activity takes place which is deemed illegal or may cause unreasonable damage, noise or disturbance. 2. Smoking takes place in the property. 3. More guests than declared at the time of booking take up occupation. Maximum occupancy includes infants/ children and cannot exceed this.
- 12. **Dissatisfaction:** Should a guest be dissatisfied for whatever reason with the accommodation secured they must notify the Stable Owners, within 2 hours of arrival. The Guest must also notify the owners immediately of any damage or defect detected during their stay. It is important that this is done whilst guests are still at the property so an on the spot investigation can be carried out fairly and remedial action taken if required and where possible. Failure to do so may result in the Guest being liable to any damages or defects.
- 13. Pets: Family pets can be taken to 4 of the Stables but must sleep in their own beds, not those at the Stable. Pets are not allowed on the furniture at the Stable and a cleaning charge of £30 per dog per day will be charged. Dogs should not be left unattended. Must be kept on a lead and prohibited from fouling areas around the Stables. Any fouling must be cleaned up by the Dog's owner and disposed of in the dog waste bin located in the access area to the bins. Please note the linen and towels provided are not for pet use. Any dogs not declared at time of booking and found to have been in the suite, will result in an additional charge which will be taken from the card supplied at booking.
- Bed Linen: Bed linen and towels for maximum occupancy are provided in the Stables. Please remove Bed Linen after your stay and leave on bedroom floor and Towels in the Bath.
- 15. **Cots and High Chairs:** Cots and High Chairs must be pre-booked prior to arrival. Bed linen and mattress are provided for cots. Based on availability.

- 16. Liability and responsibility: The owners cannot be held responsible or accept any liability for loss, damage or injury sustained whilst on the properties. Please ensure you take all of your belongings with you, we will do our best to return any items found. (see point 26.)
- 17. **Exclusion of The Rent Act:** The contract effected on confirmation of reservation relates to a holiday let only and is therefore not an assured tenancy in terms of Housing Act. This confers on the guest the right to occupy the property for the period agreed for holiday purposes only, in terms of Schedule 4 Section of the aforementioned Act.
- 18. Winter: It must be appreciated that the Stables are situated in Northumberland, where sometimes the weather can be changeable. You must satisfy yourself that your clothing and footwear is adequate for any outdoor activity and you are properly equipped for the journey to the Stables. As the Stables are in a rural area we recommend that you bring a torch.
- Adverse Travel Conditions: In the event of road closure due to adverse weather conditions or any form of 3rd party industrial action the owners cannot be held responsible for non-arrival of guests at the Stables and no refunds will be given.
- 20. Utilities: Any failure of Utility Services to any suite, e.g. electricity, water supply, wastewater services, TV signal, WiFi, refuse collection, oil or log delivery by third-party suppliers which is totally beyond the control of the Stable owners. The owners cannot be held responsible in any way and no refunds will be given in the event of any supply or service failure. Please note that our WIFI is the fastest possible available in this area.
- 21. Toiletries: We supply each Suite/Apartment with a starter bottle of Milk, a selection of tea and coffee, hotel style bathroom toiletries and two toilet rolls per bathroom 2 dishwasher tablets and 2 washing machine tablets free of charge. We expect guests to please provide all other provisions for their stay. A reminder that Chesters Stables is self catering and additional items are chargeable and not expected.
- 22. **Smoking:** We request that you do not smoke in any of the Stables. External ashtrays are provided and we ask you not to throw your cigarette buts into the yard areas. Anyone found to have been smoking within the Stable will receive an automatic fine of £200.00. If you are smoking outside please ensure the external doors are closed to prevent any smoke entering the property and setting the fire alarm off.
- 23. **Candles:** Due to the high fire risk, candles are not allowed in the suite.

- £5.00, plus any postage & packing will be levied for return of items left in the Stables after your stay.
- 25. Parking Loading and unloading is permitted in front of your stable, then all cars must be parked in the designated car parking areas signed A,B or C. Please do not park in front of any doorways on site as access is required at all times.
- 26. Rubbish Please make sure all rubbish items are correctly disposed of in the correct Refuse Bins. Guests are asked to empty bins into the general waste bin store. Failure to do so will incur a charge of £10.00.
- 27. **Terms and Conditions:** The owners reserve the right to change any of the specifications of the Stable at any time. Any changes in terms & conditions will appear on the website.
- 28. Extraordinary Circumstances: Guests should be aware that the Stable is privately owned, for events totally beyond our control, e.g. destruction of property due to flood, fire, earthquakes or acts of God; or that the property is inhabitable due to irreparable damage or on Health & Safety issues that could not reasonably have been foreseen; or because of sale or withdrawal of property by the owners. Any arising issues regarding refund of rentals in such cases will be a matter contractually between the guest and the suite owners.
- 29. **COVID-19:** The COVID-19 pandemic and subsequent restrictions are out of our control at Matfen Hall and our guests. Where government guidelines force full or partial closure of our restaurant, hotel or Chesters Stables then any deposits and bookings will become fully transferable to a future date and supersede the specific booking terms and conditions of any individual reservation. Should the future date carry higher charges for products or services then additional amounts will need to paid as part of the normal deposit process. For example, should a midweek booking be cancelled and then rebooked for a weekend, then additional charges will apply. Future dates may have a minimum length stay required.
